



2027 US Pre-College Program Early Registration Terms & Conditions

Early Registration. Early registration for 2027 Summer Programs entitles a student to reserve a seat before applications open, subject to acceptance and eligibility.

Application Process. Students who applied to and were accepted and/or enrolled on a Pre-College Program in the previous summer do not need to resubmit application materials. New applicants must submit their application materials by the Program's application deadlines. If a student is not accepted onto the Program or is ineligible to attend (e.g., due to age restrictions), the Early Registration Fee will be refunded in full.

Enrollment and Course Selection. Students who sign up and pay the Early Registration Fee by **October 15, 2026** will have priority course selection before applications open for all applicants. Please note that enrollment is not complete until the full program fees are paid. Students who sign up and pay the Early Registration Fee but do not enroll within one month of the application opening will lose their reserved seat in their selected course, but may still enroll in the program and select their course subject to availability.

Early Registration Fees. A fee of \$500 is required for Early Registration. This Early Registration Fee will be deducted from your final tuition balance upon enrollment. Students who do not enroll in the Program by October 31, 2026 will be eligible for a full refund of the Early Registration Fee. After enrollment, the school's refund policy outlined in the Program Terms & Conditions will apply to all payments, including the Early Registration Fee.

Program Fees and Discounts. Fees for the Program are reviewed annually and will be communicated in advance of enrollment. Students who complete Early Registration are also entitled to take advantage of the \$350 Early Bird Discount.

Scholarship Eligibility. Participating in Early Registration does not impact a student's eligibility for scholarships. Students interested in applying for scholarship support may do so when the scholarship application opens to the public.

Program Terms and Conditions. All other Program terms and conditions apply, and students who participate in the Summer Pre-College Program must agree to these terms, including but not limited to the Student Code of Conduct. Program terms and conditions are subject to change, and the school reserves the right to make changes to program fees and course schedules. Material changes will be communicated to you prior to enrollment. Enrollment offers may be withdrawn from students who have violated Program terms and conditions.
